# A Chronology of the Life of Hugh Winder Nibley

- 7 May 1876 Alexander (“El”) Nibley is born to Charles W. Nibley and his first wife, Rebecca Neibaur Nibley.
- 17 Oct. 1885 Agnes Sloan (“Sloanie”) is born in Manti to Hugh Russel Sloan and Margaret Violet Reid Sloan.
- 17 June 1902 El Nibley marries Constance Thatcher.
- 1905 Constance dies in giving birth to a daughter, Connie, who is raised by the Thatchers.
- 1906 El, on a mission in Holland, meets Agnes Sloan (“Sloanie”) in Berlin.
- 4 Dec. 1907 Charles W. Nibley is sustained as Presiding Bishop.
- 27 June 1907 El and Sloanie are married and move to Portland, Oregon, where El manages his father’s lumber interests.
- 23 June 1908 Alexander Sloan Nibley is born to El and Sloanie in Portland.
- 27 Mar. 1910 Hugh Winder Sloan is born to El and Sloanie Nibley in Portland, Oregon.
- 29 Apr. 1913 Fred Richard Nibley is born in Portland.
- early 1917 The Nibley family moves to Medford, Oregon, where El manages Utah-Idaho Sugar Company for his father.
- 25 July 1917 Philip Gordon Nibley is born.
- 27 Mar. 1918 Hugh is baptized at Medford, Oregon.
- 1919 The Nibley family moves back to Portland, Oregon, where El is a purchasing agent for a sugar company.
